We're No Hero's

The band was originally formed back in late 2005, but were then operating under a different name. Back then they were heavily influenced by the 70's Funk Scene and played a large number of gigs throughout the Swansea Pub circuit, until 2007 when the band members decided to call it a day.

After a two year break, during which the boys considered a change of musical direction, a new format was agreed and a plan was formulated.

They spent the next six months creating a set based on the music Cut Copy, Battles, The Raptures, Friendly Fires and Fela Kuti . The new Indie style band hit the road with gigs at Barfly, Clwb Ifor Bach and Milkwoodjam and more local gigs are in the pipeline.

Tom Collins is on Lead Guitar and Vocals and Keys, Michael Owen plays Bass and shares some of the vocals, while Luke Llewellyn provides the percussion and additional vocals.

The band now play mostly original material with a few covers thrown in for good measure and their debut EP is now available as a free download. Check out the bands website for more details
